- 1 **pair** earbuds in baggie with name



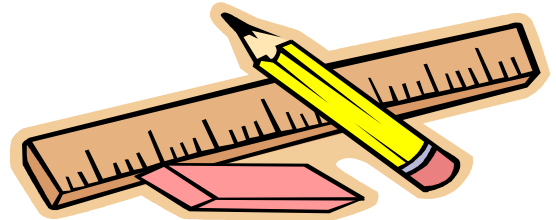
FOURTH GRADE
