- 1 ½ **inch binder** – Barnes class only



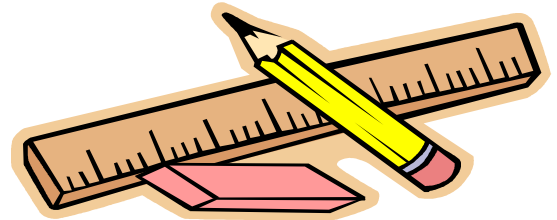
FOURTH GRADE
